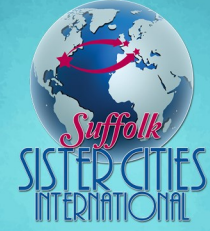

# Sister Cities

## ...IN THE WORLD

President Eisenhower proposed a people-to-people organization in 1956 to bring cities together, to increase global understanding and to enhance world peace. In 1967, this initiative became Sister Cities International (SCI), which now unites tens of thousands of citizen diplomats and volunteers in 570 member communities with over 2,300 partnerships in 150 countries on six continents.

## ...IN OUR CITY

In 1981, Suffolk established its first Sister City relationship with Suffolk County, England. Suffolk's second Sister City affiliation with Oderzo, Italy, began in 1995 because of one man's connection with our two cities. Amedeo Obici, an immigrant from Oderzo, founded Planters Nut and Chocolate Company and Obici Hospital in Suffolk.

Suffolk Sister Cities International, Inc. (SSCI) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit established to promote international relationships established by Suffolk City Council. Its membership is open to all who are interested in fostering the goals of the organization.

SSCI and its international youth association, SIYA, have won national awards for Youth and Education and for the best Overall Program for cities with populations less than 100,000.

# Italy

## ODERZO

Between Venice and the beautiful Dolomite Mountains lies Oderzo, a small, friendly city of 16,000 people. Situated on the Monticano River, Oderzo is known as the "Archaeological City," as its land was

crossed by an old Roman road built in 148 B.C. The municipality's archaeological ruins are well-preserved in its Civic Museum of Archaeology, one of the oldest museums in Italy. Oderzo's Roman name, Opitergium, means "the village of the market" and today, it remains a popular, upscale shopping mecca.



Oderzo, known as the city of the old and the new, comes alive with artists, craftsmen, fashion shows, festivals, shops, and restaurants. Once a year, the town stages an outdoor opera in the piazza, complete with elaborate sets and costuming.



Symbolizing the strong friendship between our two cities are Suffolk's Obici-Oderzo Fountain, designed by Oderzo architect Paolo Rossi, and a Mr. Peanut® statue that stands proudly at Amedeo Obici High School in Oderzo.
